These Terms of Use are a legally binding contract between you and Northeastern Power and Gas LLC regarding your use of the Site.

BY ACCESSING OR USING THE SITE, YOU AGREE THAT YOU HAVE READ AND UNDERSTOOD, AND, AS A CONDITION TO YOUR USE OF THE SITE, YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY, THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS, INCLUDING THE PRIVACY POLICY (DEFINED BELOW) (TOGETHER, THESE "TERMS"). IF YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE, OR DO NOT AGREE TO THE TERMS, THEN YOU DO NOT HAVE OUR PERMISSION TO USE THE SITE. 1. Services Overview.

In addition to the Site, we offer our digital energy experience, mobile application, and other software (including, without limitation, the **Northeastern Power and Gas LLC Integrated Software**) (collectively, the "**Services**"), and the products made available for sale by Northeastern Power and Gas LLC through the Services ("**Products**"). In order to use the Services, you may be required to register for an applicable Product. Each of the Services and Products may be governed by a separate Terms of Use, Terms of Service, or

Terms and Conditions document ("**Product and Service Terms**"). All Services are subject to our Electronic Signature and Communication Disclosure ("**Electronic Signature and Communication Disclosure**") and Privacy Policy ("**Privacy Policy**"), which will be made available to you prior to enrolling in or initiating any Services, and you must agree to any applicable Product and Service Terms, the Electronic Signature and Communication Disclosure, and Privacy Policy in order to use the Services.

2. Eligibility

You must be at least 18 years old to use the Site. By agreeing to these Terms, you represent and warrant to us that:

- a. you are at least 18 years old;
- b. you have not previously been suspended or removed from the Site or any other service provided by Northeastern Power and Gas LLC; and
- your use of the Site is in compliance with any and all applicable laws and regulations.

3. Licenses

3.1 Limited License

Subject to your complete and ongoing compliance with these Terms, Northeastern Power and Gas LLC grants you, solely for your personal, use, a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, non-sublicensable, revocable license to access and use the Site.

3.2 License Restrictions

Except and solely to the extent such a restriction is impermissible under applicable law, you may not:

- a. reproduce, distribute, publicly display, or publicly perform the Site;
- b. make modifications to the Site; or
- c. interfere with or circumvent any feature of the Site, including any security or access control mechanism.

If you are prohibited under applicable law from using the Site, you may not use it.

3.3 User Comments, Feedback, and Other Submissions.

Northeastern Power and Gas LLC takes no responsibility and assumes no liability for any Comments posted by you or any third party.

4. Ownership; Proprietary Rights.

The Site is owned and operated by Northeastern Power and Gas LLC. The visual interfaces, graphics, design, compilation, information, data, computer code (including source code or object code), products, software, services, and all other elements of the Site ("**Materials**") provided by Northeastern Power and Gas LLC are protected by

intellectual property and other laws. All Materials included in the Site are the property of Northeastern Power and Gas LLC or its third-party licensors. Except as expressly authorized by Northeastern Power and Gas LLC, you may not make use of the Materials. Northeastern Power and Gas LLC reserves all rights to the Materials not granted expressly in these Terms.

5. Linked Websites.

The Site may contain links to third-party websites. Linked websites are not under Northeastern Power and Gas LLC's control, and Northeastern Power and Gas LLC is not responsible for their content.

6. Prohibited Conduct.

By using the Site you agree not to:

- 1. use the Site for any illegal purpose or in violation of any local, state, national, or international law;
- 2. violate, or encourage others to violate, any right of a third party, including by infringing or misappropriating any third-party intellectual property right;
- 3. copy, distribute, or disclose any part of the Site in any medium, including without limitation by any automated or non-automated "scraping";
- 4. bypass any measures we may use to prevent or restrict access to the Site, including features that prevent or restrict use or copying of any Materials;

7. Notice and Procedure for Making Claims of Copyright Infringement

- 3. A description where the material that you claim is infringing is located on the site;
- 4. Your address, telephone number, and email address;

9. Term.

These Terms are effective beginning when you accept the Terms or first access, or use the Site, and ending when terminated as described in this Section ("**Term**"). We reserve the right, at our own expense, to assume the exclusive defense and control of any matter otherwise subject to indemnification by you (without limiting your indemnification obligations with respect to that matter), and in that case, you agree to cooperate with our defense of those claims.

TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, IN NO EVENT WILL THE NORTHEASTERN POWER AND GAS LLC ENTITIES BE LIABLE TO YOU FOR ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES (INCLUDING DAMAGES FOR LOSS OF PROFITS, GOODWILL, OR ANY OTHER INTANGIBLE LOSS) ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO YOUR ACCESS TO OR USE OF, OR YOUR INABILITY TO ACCESS OR USE, THE SITE OR ANY MATERIALS OR CONTENT ON THE SITE, WHETHER BASED ON WARRANTY, CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), STATUTE, OR ANY OTHER LEGAL THEORY, AND WHETHER OR NOT ANY NORTHEASTERN POWER AND GAS LLC ENTITY HAS BEEN INFORMED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF DAMAGE.

TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, THE AGGREGATE LIABILITY OF THE NORTHEASTERN POWER AND GAS LLC ENTITIES TO YOU FOR ALL CLAIMS ARISING OUT OF OR RELATING TO THE USE OF OR ANY INABILITY TO USE ANY PORTION OF THE SITE OR OTHERWISE UNDER THESE TERMS, WHETHER IN CONTRACT, TORT, OR OTHERWISE, IS LIMITED TO \$100.

EACH PROVISION OF THESE TERMS THAT PROVIDES FOR A LIMITATION OF LIABILITY, DISCLAIMER OF WARRANTIES, OR EXCLUSION OF DAMAGES IS INTENDED TO AND DOES ALLOCATE THE RISKS BETWEEN THE PARTIES UNDER THESE TERMS. THIS ALLOCATION IS AN ESSENTIAL ELEMENT OF THE BASIS OF THE BARGAIN BETWEEN THE PARTIES. EACH OF THESE PROVISIONS IS SEVERABLE AND INDEPENDENT OF ALL OTHER PROVISIONS OF THESE TERMS. 13. Dispute Resolution and Arbitration Agreement

13.1 Informal Dispute Resolution.

Mindful of the high cost, time, and energy of legal disputes, both you and Northeastern Power and Gas LLC agree to the following dispute resolution procedure: In the event of any controversy, claim, action or dispute arising out of or related to any transaction conducted on the Site, or the breach, enforcement, interpretation, or validity of these

Terms ("Dispute"), the party asserting the Dispute shall first try in good faith to settle such Dispute by providing written notice to the other party describing the facts and circumstances (including any relevant documentation) of the Dispute and allowing the receiving party 30 days in which to respond to or settle the Dispute. Notice shall be sent:

- (a) to Northeastern Power and Gas LLC at: Northeastern Power and Gas LLC, Attn: General Counsel, 11 Covert St. 2FL Brooklyn NY 11207 or
- (b) to you at: your last-used or publicly available email address or postal address. Both you and Northeastern Power and Gas LLC agree that this dispute resolution procedure is a condition precedent which must be satisfied prior to initiating any arbitration or filing any claim against the other party.
- **13.2 Arbitration.** To the extent any Dispute cannot be resolved through the informal dispute resolution procedure described above, a Dispute shall be resolved through binding individual arbitration. Arbitration is less formal than a lawsuit in court. Arbitration uses a neutral arbitrator instead of a judge or jury, may allow for more limited discovery than in court, and can be subject to very limited review by courts. Arbitrators can award the same damages and relief that a court can award. This agreement to arbitrate Disputes includes all claims arising out of or relating to any aspect of these Terms, whether based in contract, tort, statute, fraud, misrepresentation or any other legal theory, and regardless of whether a claim arises during or after the termination of these Terms. YOU UNDERSTAND AND AGREE THAT, BY ENTERING INTO THESE TERMS, YOU AND NORTHEASTERN POWER AND GAS LLC ARE EACH WAIVING THE RIGHT TO A TRIAL BY JURY OR TO PARTICIPATE IN A CLASS ACTION.
- **13.3 Exceptions.** Nothing in these Terms will be deemed to waive, preclude, or otherwise limit the right of either party to: (a) bring an individual action in small claims court; (b) pursue an enforcement action through the applicable federal, state or local agency if that action is available; (c) seek injunctive relief in a court of law in aid of arbitration; or (d) to file suit in a court of law to address an intellectual property infringement claim.
- **13.4 Arbitrator.** Any arbitration between you and Northeastern Power and Gas LLC will be settled under the Federal Arbitration Act and administered by the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") under its Consumer Arbitration Rules (collectively, "AAA Rules") as modified by these Terms. The AAA Rules and filing forms are available online at www.adr.org, by calling the AAA at 1-800-778-7879, or by contacting Northeastern Power and Gas LLC. The arbitrator has exclusive authority to resolve any dispute relating to the interpretation, applicability or enforceability of this binding arbitration agreement.

13.5 Notice of Arbitration; Process. A party who intends to seek arbitration must first send a written notice of the Dispute to the other party by certified U.S. Mail or by Federal Express (signature required) or, only if that other party has not provided a current physical address, then by electronic mail ("Notice of Arbitration"). Northeastern Power and Gas LLC's address for Notice is: Northeastern Power and Gas LLC, 11 Covert St. 2FL Brooklyn NY 11207. The Notice of Arbitration must: (a) describe the nature and basis of the claim or Dispute; and (b) set forth the specific relief sought ("Demand"). The parties will make good faith efforts to resolve the claim directly, but if the parties do not reach an agreement to do so within 30 days after the Notice of Arbitration is received, you or Northeastern Power and Gas LLC may commence an arbitration proceeding. All arbitration proceedings between the parties will be confidential unless otherwise agreed by the parties in writing. During the arbitration, the amount of any settlement offer made by you or Northeastern Power and Gas LLC must not be disclosed to the arbitrator until after the arbitrator makes a final decision and award, if any. If the arbitrator awards you an amount higher than the last written settlement amount offered by Northeastern Power and Gas LLC in settlement of the dispute prior to the award, Northeastern Power and Gas LLC will pay to you the higher of: (i) the amount awarded by the arbitrator; or (ii) \$10,000.

13.6 Fees. If you commence arbitration in accordance with these Terms, Northeastern Power and Gas LLC will reimburse you for your payment of the filing fee, unless your claim is for more than \$10,000, in which case the payment of any fees will be decided by the AAA Rules. Any arbitration hearing will take place at a location to be agreed upon in Los Angeles County, California, but if the claim is for \$10,000 or less, you may choose whether the arbitration will be conducted: (a) solely on the basis of documents submitted to the arbitrator; (b) through a non-appearance based telephone hearing; or (c) by an in-person hearing as established by the AAA Rules in the county (or parish) of your billing address. If the arbitrator finds that either the substance of your claim or the relief sought in the Demand is frivolous or brought for an improper purpose (as measured by the standards set forth in Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 11(b)), then the payment of all fees will be governed by the AAA Rules. In that case, you agree to reimburse Northeastern Power and Gas LLC for all monies previously disbursed by it that are otherwise your obligation to pay under the AAA Rules. Regardless of the manner in which the arbitration is conducted, the arbitrator must issue a reasoned written decision sufficient to explain the essential findings and conclusions on which the decision and award, if any, are based. The arbitrator may make rulings and resolve disputes as to the payment and reimbursement of fees or expenses at any time during the proceeding and upon request from either party made within 14 days of the arbitrator's ruling on the merits.

13.7 No Class Actions. YOU AND NORTHEASTERN POWER AND GAS LLC AGREE THAT EACH MAY BRING CLAIMS AGAINST THE OTHER ONLY IN YOUR OR ITS INDIVIDUAL CAPACITY AND NOT AS A PLAINTIFF OR CLASS MEMBER IN ANY PURPORTED CLASS OR REPRESENTATIVE PROCEEDING. Further, unless both you and Northeastern Power and Gas LLC agree otherwise, the arbitrator may not consolidate more than one person's claims and may not otherwise preside over any form of a representative or class proceeding.

13.8 Enforceability. If this arbitration agreement is found to be unenforceable, then the entirety of this will be null and void and, in that case, the exclusive jurisdiction and venue described in Section 14 below will govern any action arising out of or related to these Terms.

14. Miscellaneous.

14.1 General Terms.

These Terms, together with the Privacy Policy and any Additional Terms (defined below), are the entire and exclusive understanding and agreement between you and Northeastern Power and Gas LLC regarding your use of the Site. You may not assign or transfer these Terms or your rights under these Terms, in whole or in part, by operation of law or otherwise, without our prior written consent. We may assign these Terms at any time without notice or consent. The failure to require performance of any provision will not affect our right to require performance at any other time after that, nor will a waiver by us of any breach or default of these Terms, or any provision of these Terms, be a waiver of any subsequent breach or default or a waiver of the provision itself. Use of section headers in these Terms is for convenience only and will not have any impact on the interpretation of any provision. Throughout these Terms the use of the word "including" means "including but not limited to". If any part of these Terms is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the unenforceable part will be given effect to the greatest extent possible, and the remaining parts will remain in full force and effect.

14.2 Governing Law.

These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of New York without regard to conflict of law principles that would result in the application of the laws of another jurisdiction. You and Northeastern Power and Gas LLC submit to the personal and exclusive jurisdiction of the state courts and federal courts located within New York County, New York for resolution of any lawsuit or court proceeding permitted under these Terms.

14.3 Privacy Policy.

Please read the Privacy Policy carefully for information relating to our collection, use, storage, disclosure of your personal information. The Privacy Policy is incorporated by this reference into, and made a part of, these Terms.

14.4 Additional Terms.

Your use of the Site is subject to all additional terms, policies, rules, or guidelines applicable to the Site or certain features of the Site that we may post on or link to from the Site or that you agree to in connection with certain technology or services made available to you by or on behalf of Northeastern Power and Gas LLC (the "Additional Terms"). All Additional Terms are incorporated by this reference into, and made a part of, these Terms.

14.5 Consent to Electronic Communications.

By using the Site, you consent to receiving certain electronic communications from us. You agree that any notices, agreements, disclosures, or other communications that we send to you electronically will satisfy any legal communication requirements, including that those communications be in writing.

14.6 Contact Information.
